Agenda Item Title: Update on the Earthquake Ready Burnside Bridge Project

Purpose/Objective: The Earthquake Ready Burnside Bridge project has been advancing through the design phase to become construction-ready. The purpose of this briefing will be to update JPACT on the project's milestones, progress, and plans for the future.

Outcome: JPACT has been a key partner to advance the project to this stage. After this briefing, JPACT members will have a better understanding of the project status and will have an opportunity to ask questions about the project. Multnomah County is grateful for JPACT's support so far, and hopes to maintain that momentum through design and into the next phase.

What has changed since JPACT last considered this issue/item? EQRB came before JPACT for a brief update during the RFFA process, but our last full update was in February of 2023 when JPACT approved our LPA. Since adoption of our LPA, Multnomah County has received \$20 million in state funding, the Board of Commissioners has adopted the inverted Y design as our preferred alternative with the partnership of a Community Design Advisory Group, and we have advanced to nearly 60% design.
