Executive Summary

The Regional Strategy Implementation Fund, commonly referred to as the Regional Investment Fund (RIF), is a requirement under SHS intergovernmental agreements that each county commit a minimum of five percent of its supportive housing services program funds each fiscal year to regional goals, strategies, and outcomes.

This agenda item will include the following:

- Regional Investment Fund overview: The presentation will guide committee members through the history of RIF and a high-level overview of the six original regional goals that will be discussed in further detail at future committee meetings.
- RIF reform progress: In 2025 and 2026, Metro Council approved a set of resolutions and ordinances that direct reforms to improve how SHS is implemented and managed. RIF reform was one of the key areas, and the presentation will highlight the reform and progress thus far.
- Discussion and next steps: A discussion will be held to gather feedback from the committee members on the RIF topics presented.
