

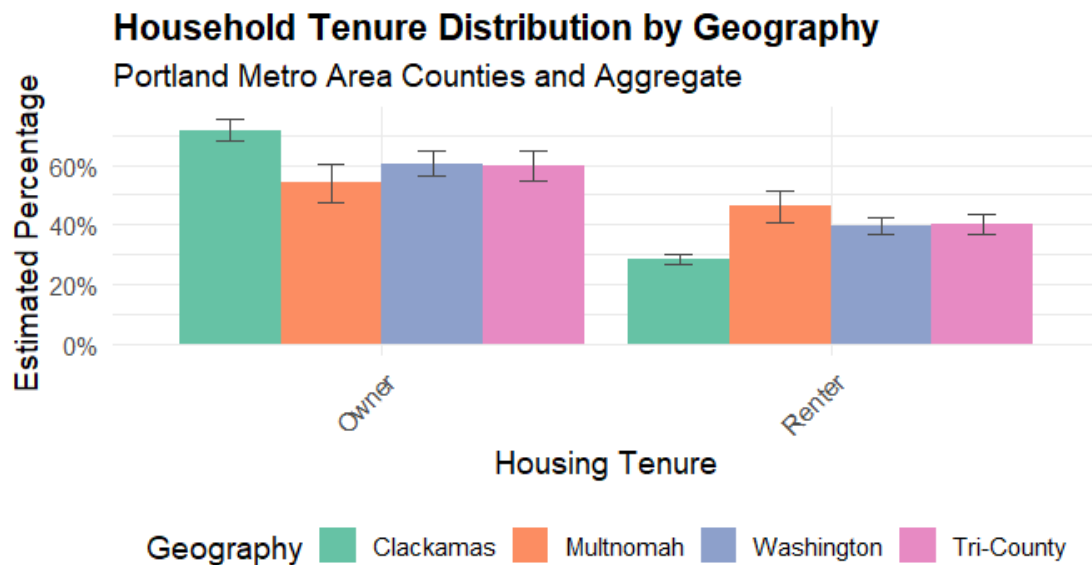
Appendix 1: Household Socioeconomic and Demographic Characteristics

Considerations related to census data

Different communities have different levels of comfort while engaging with government censuses and surveys, which can result in undercounts. Additionally, estimates of smaller and harder-to-count populations tend to have less reliability than estimates for larger segments of the population. To increase reliability, the American Community Survey often publishes aggregated categories, which can mask important trends in the data, especially regarding race, ethnicity, and language.

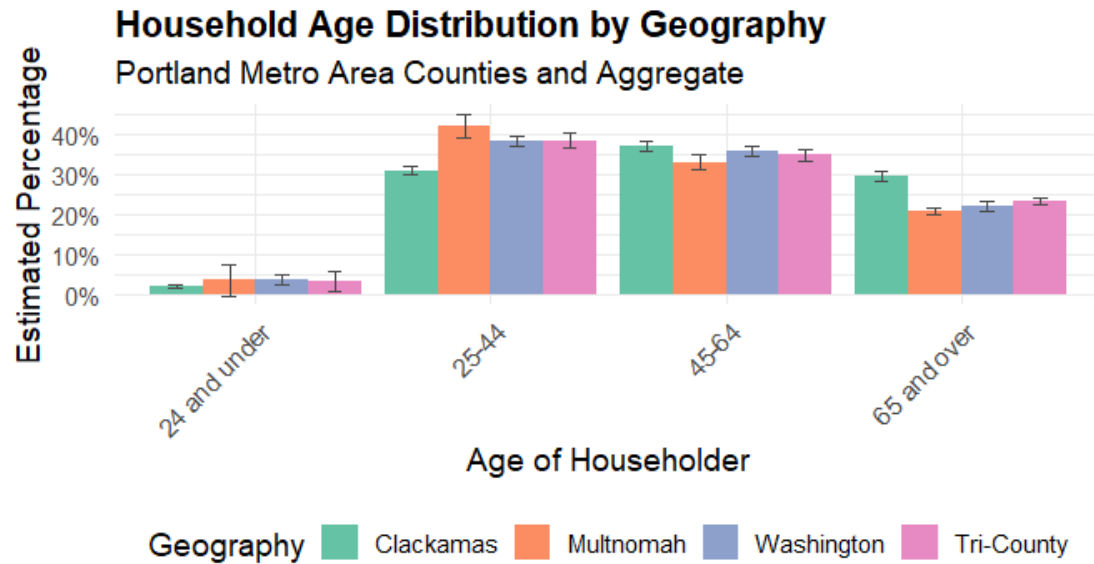
The default confidence interval for both ACS and PUMS data is 90%, as this is the statistical standard set by the U.S. Census Bureau for publishing these estimates. This means that the published margin of error corresponds to a 90% confidence level, providing approximately 90% certainty that the true population value falls within the calculated confidence bounds.

Household Tenure



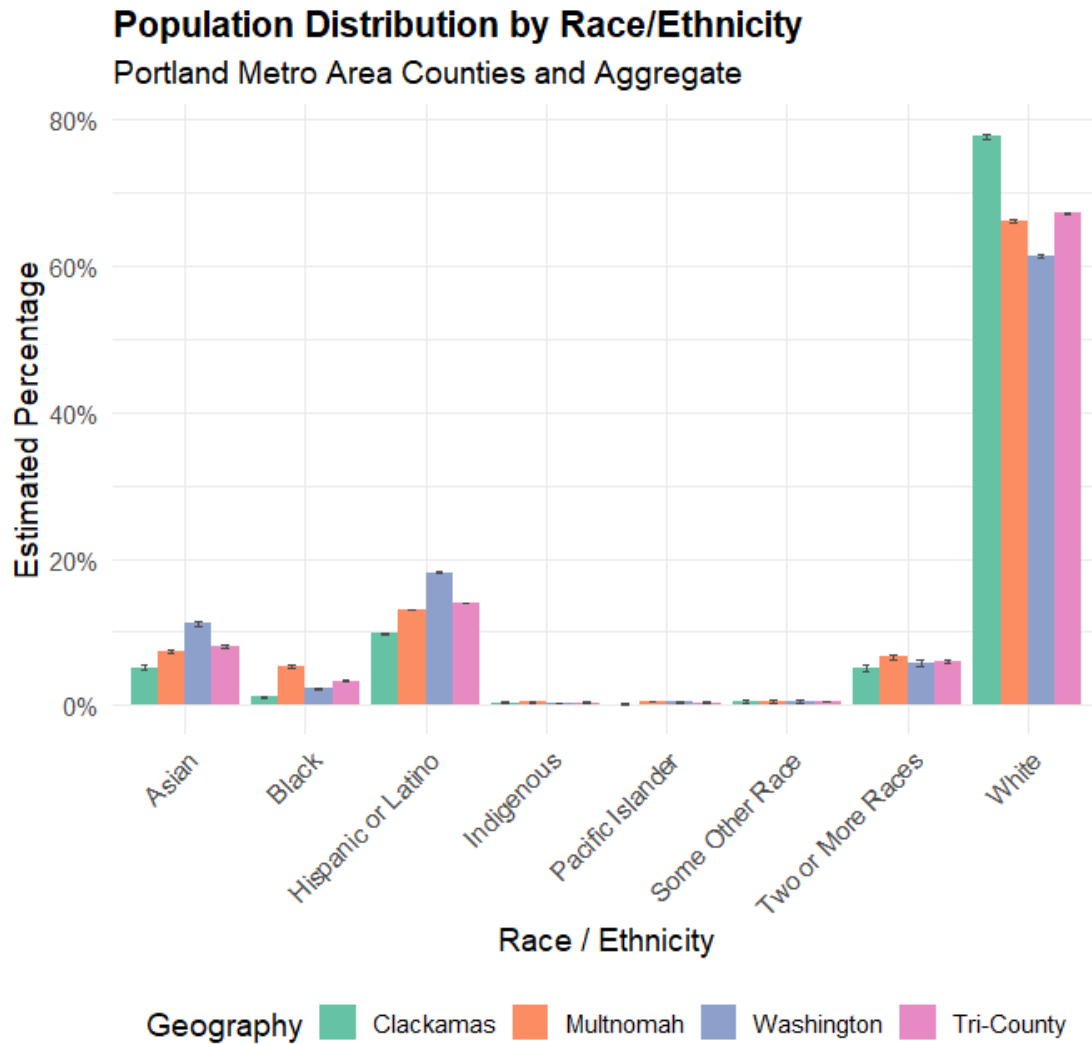

Age of Householder



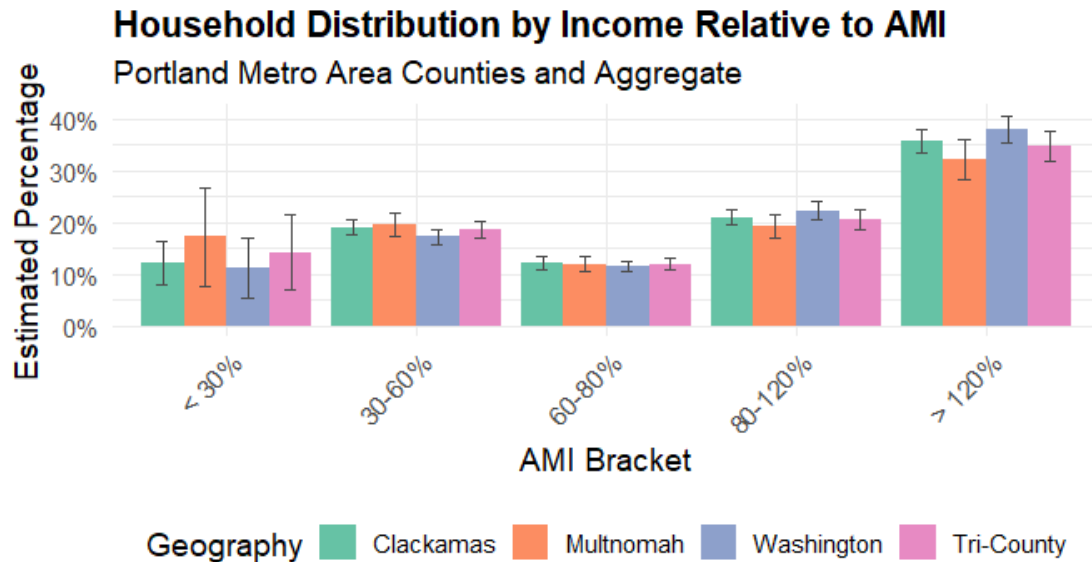

Race and Ethnicity



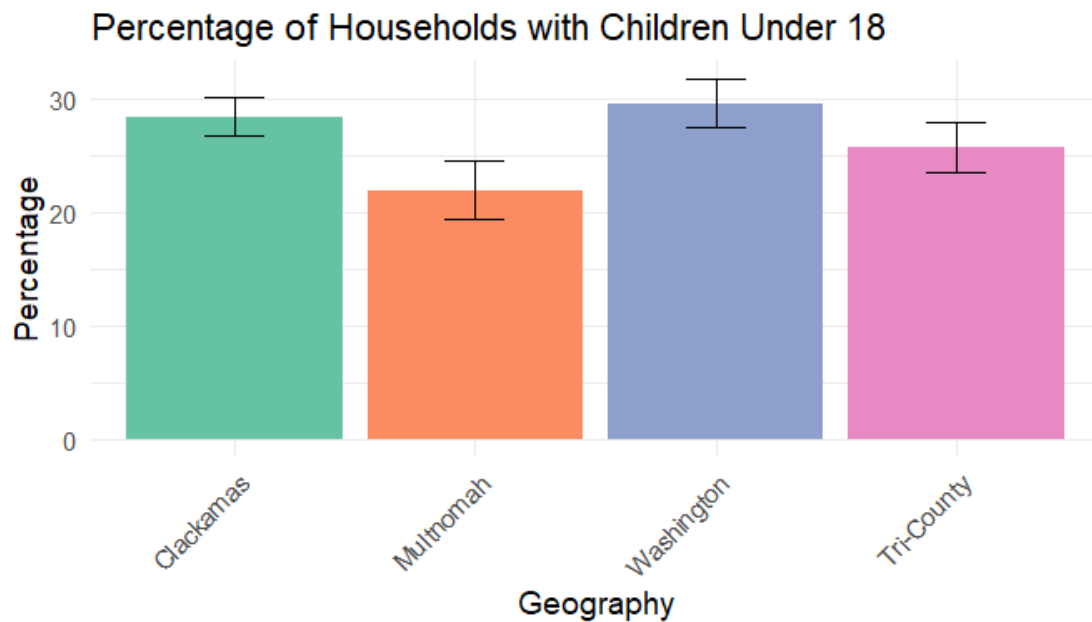

Household Income Relative to Area Median Income (AMI)

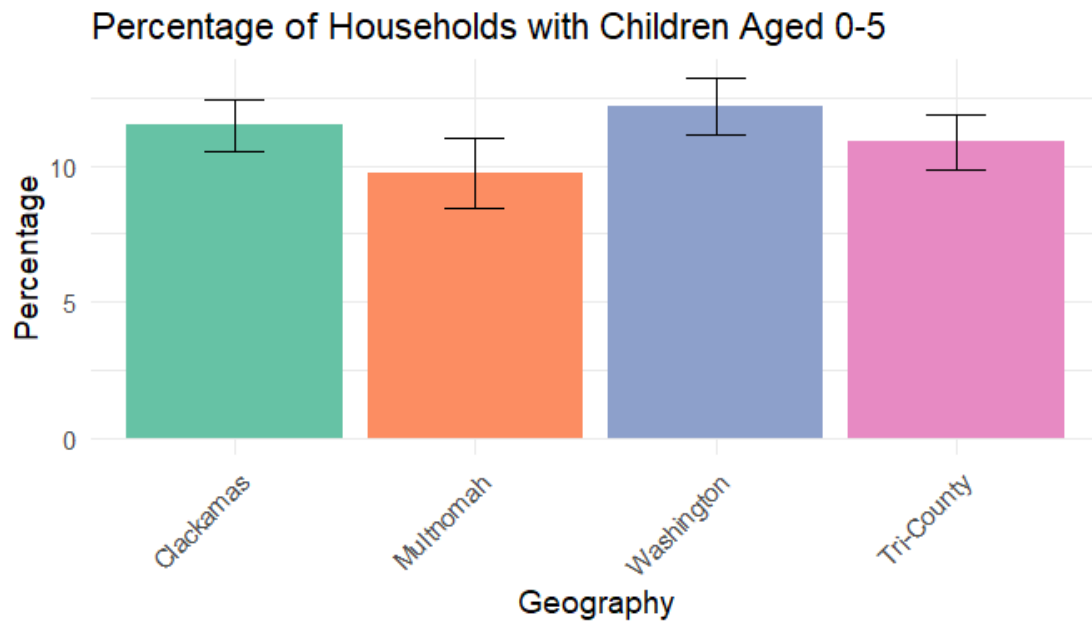

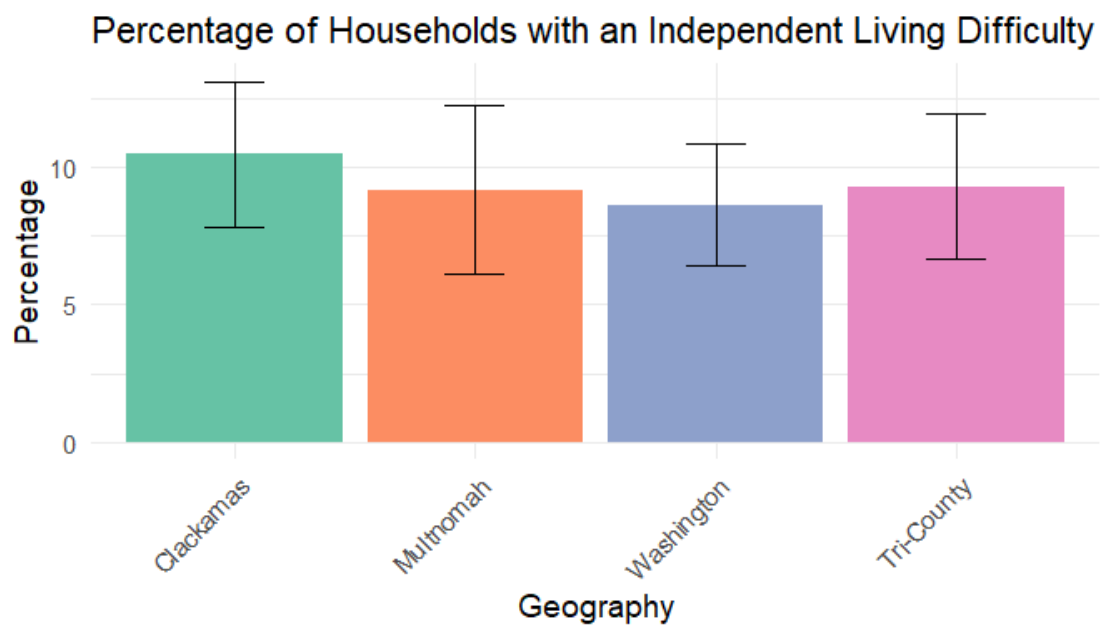

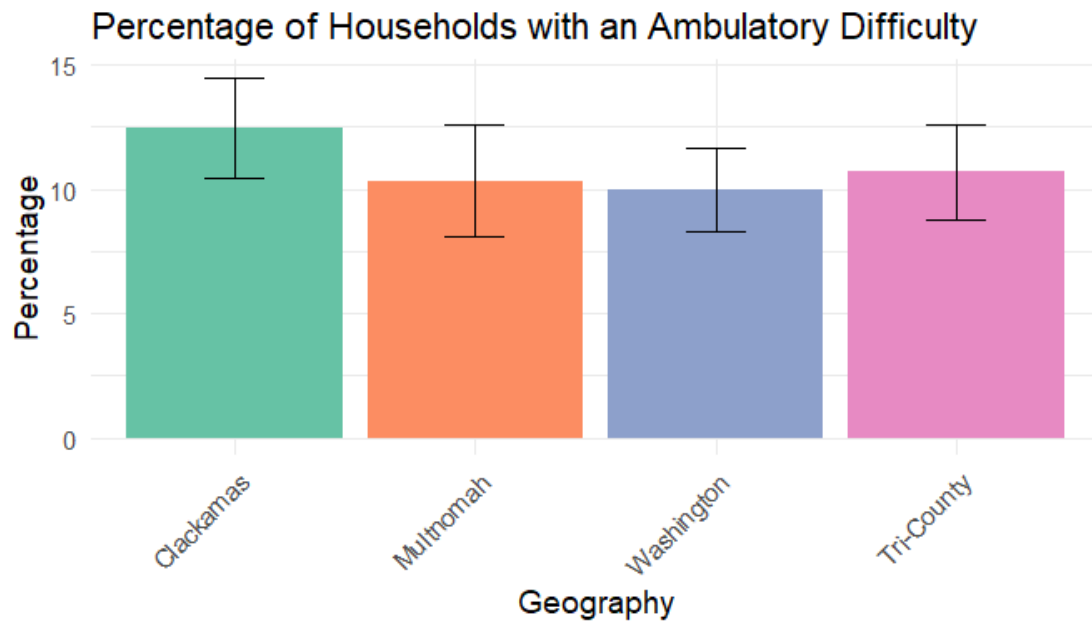
Households with Children Aged 0-5



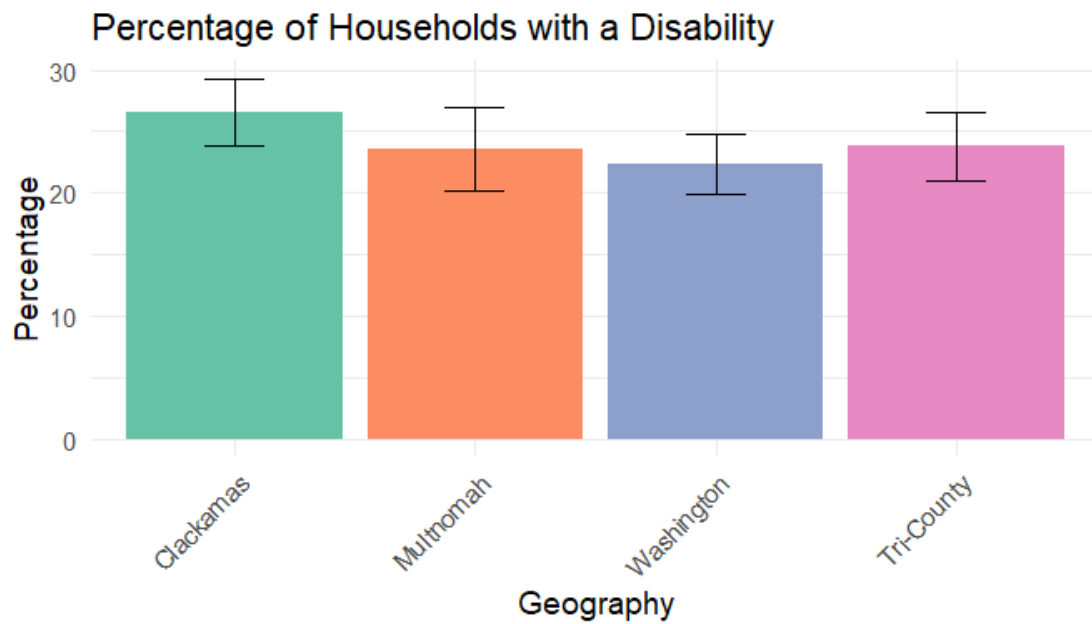
Households with an Independent Living Difficulty



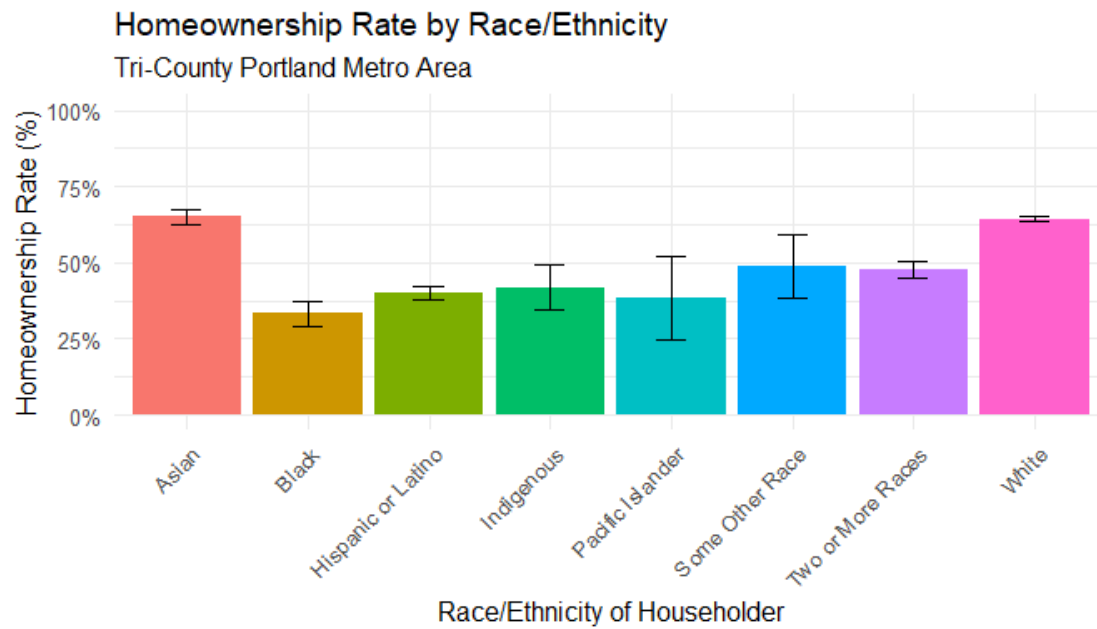
Households with an Ambulatory Difficulty



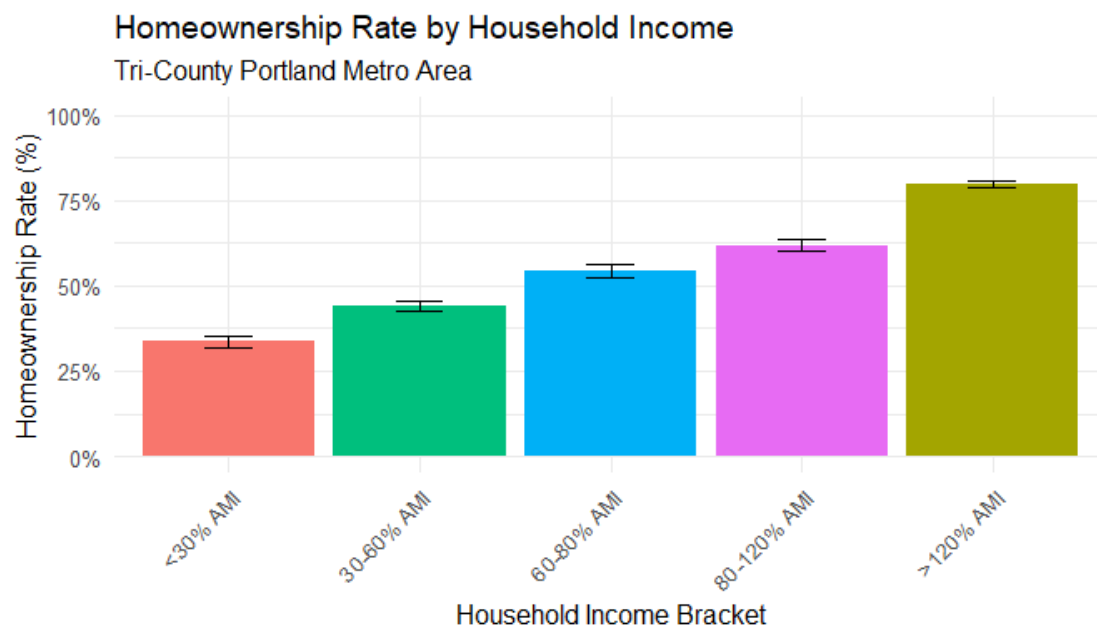
Households with a Disability



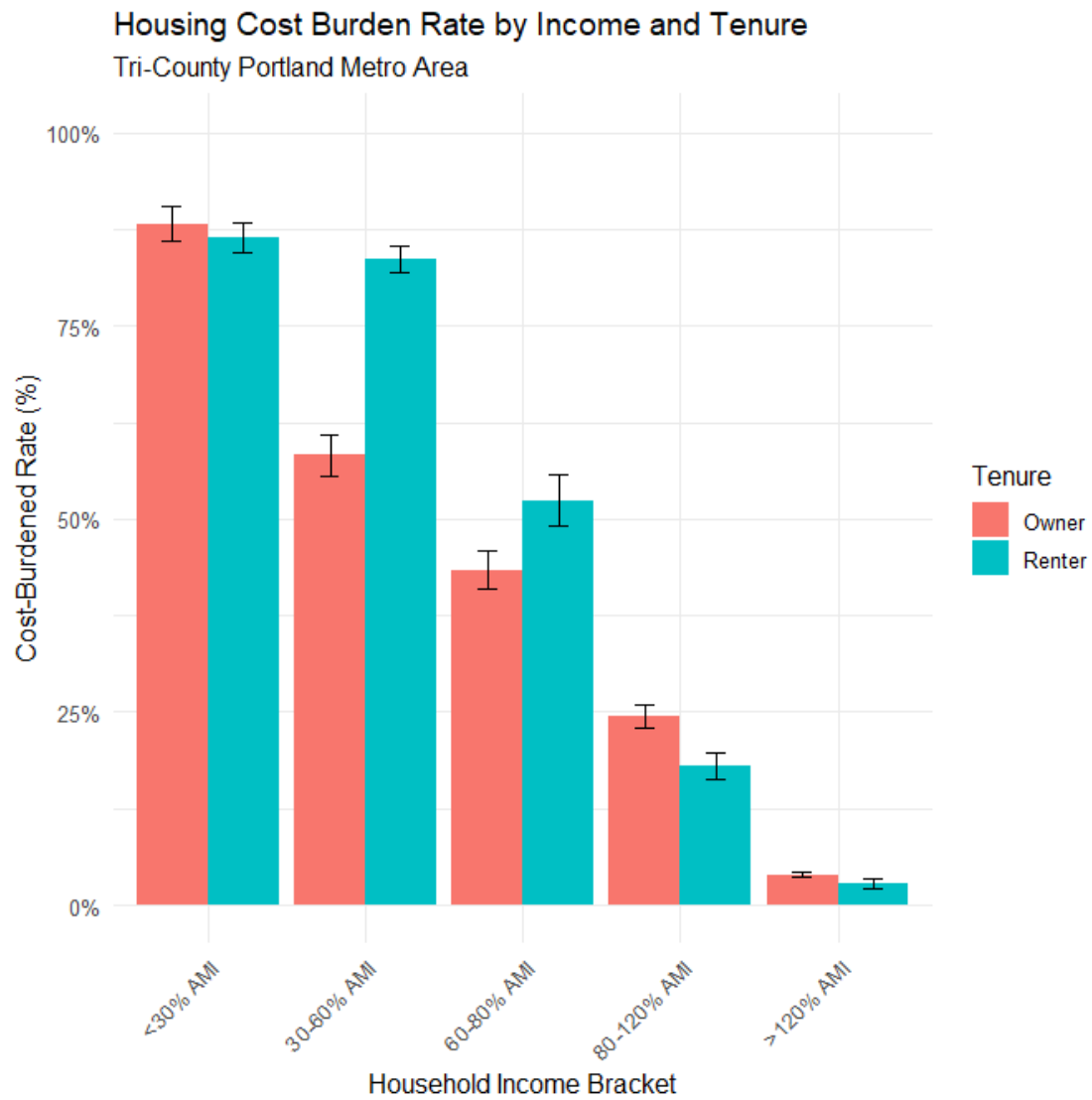
Home Ownership Rate by Race/Ethnicity



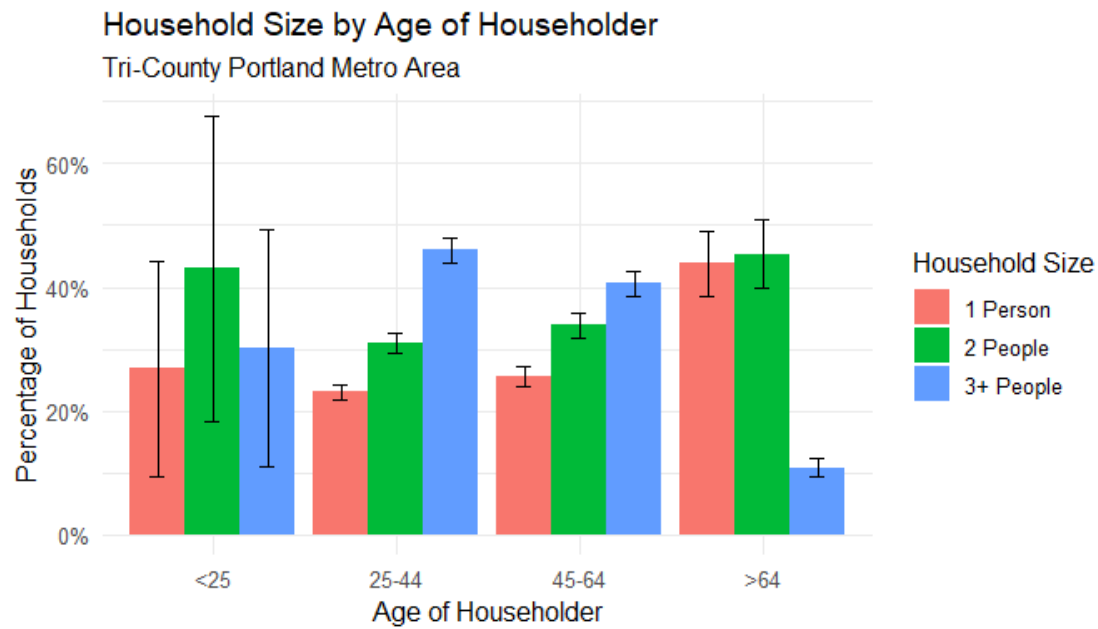
Home Ownership Rate by Household Income (AMI)



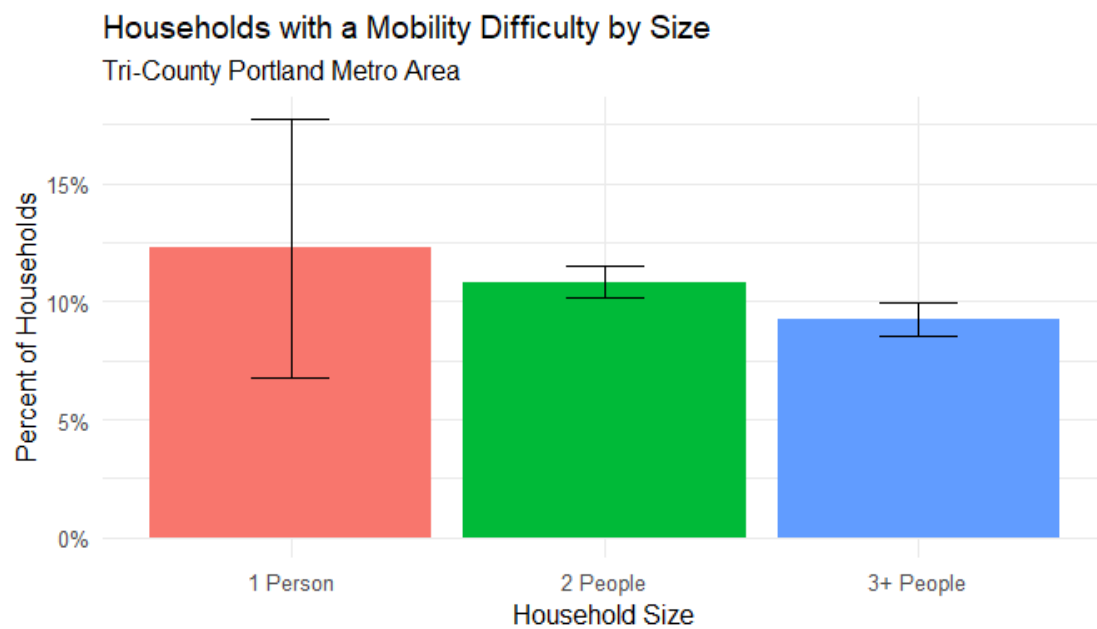
Housing Cost Burden Rate by Income and Tenure



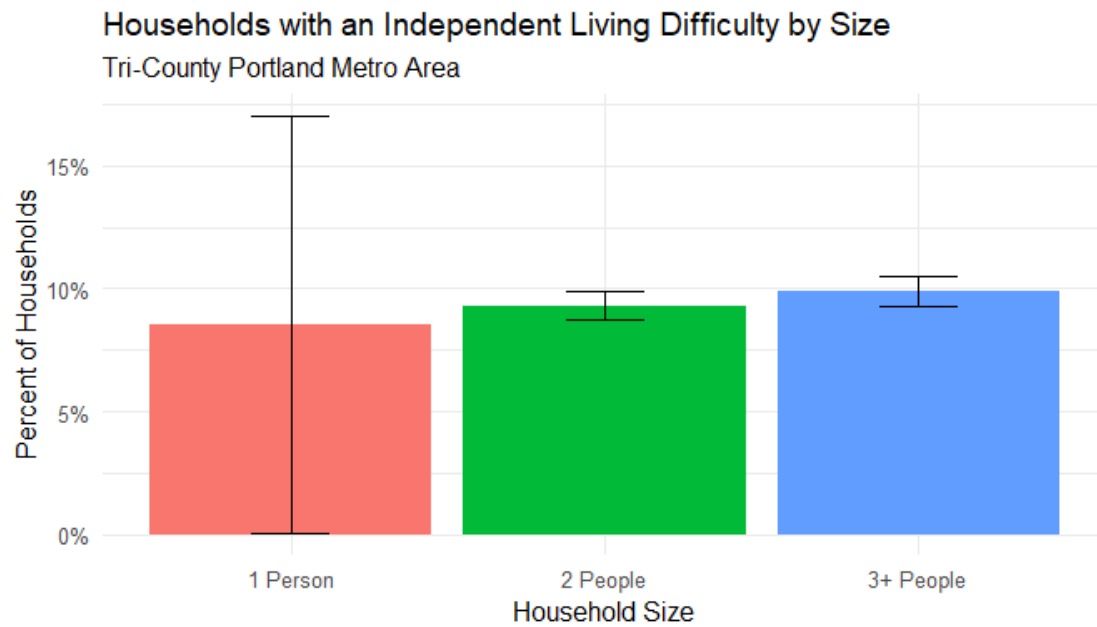
Household Size by Age of Householder



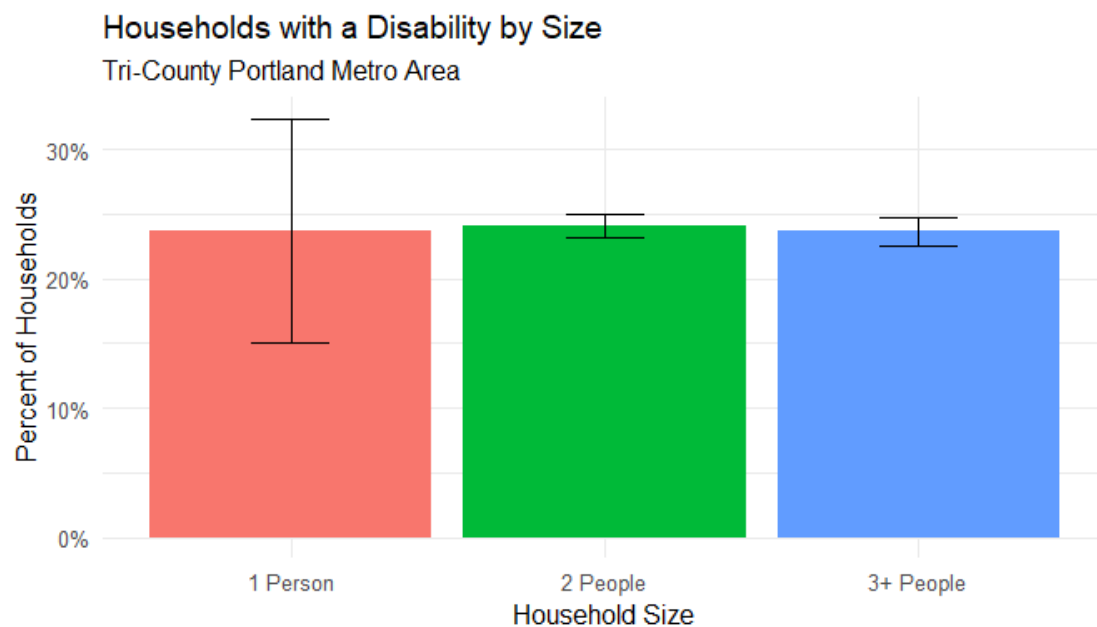
Household with a Mobility Disability by Household Size



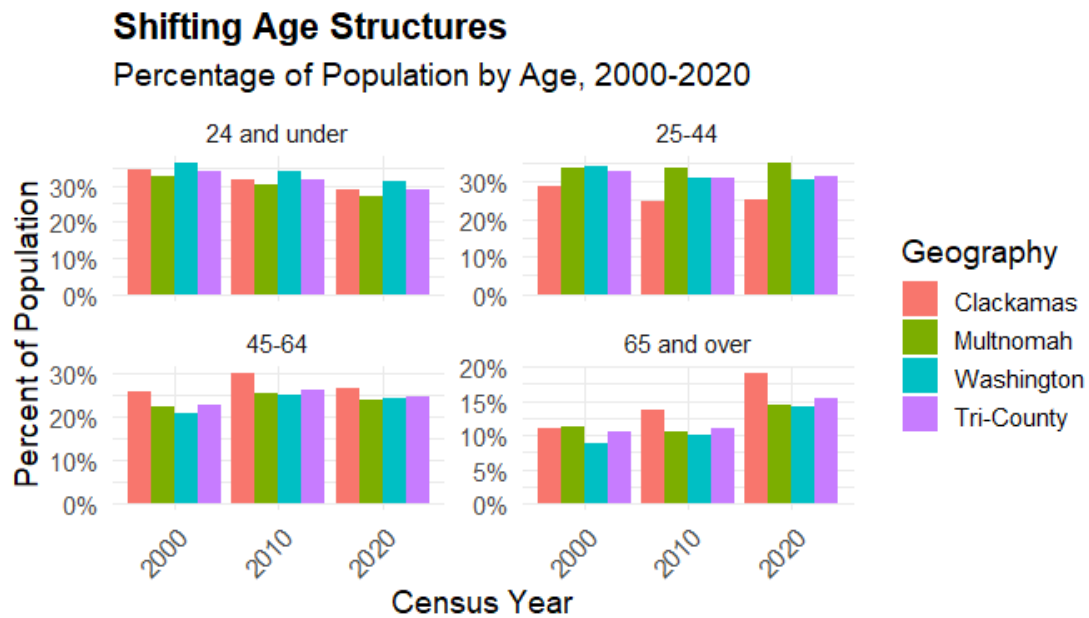
Households with an Independent Living Difficulty by Household Size



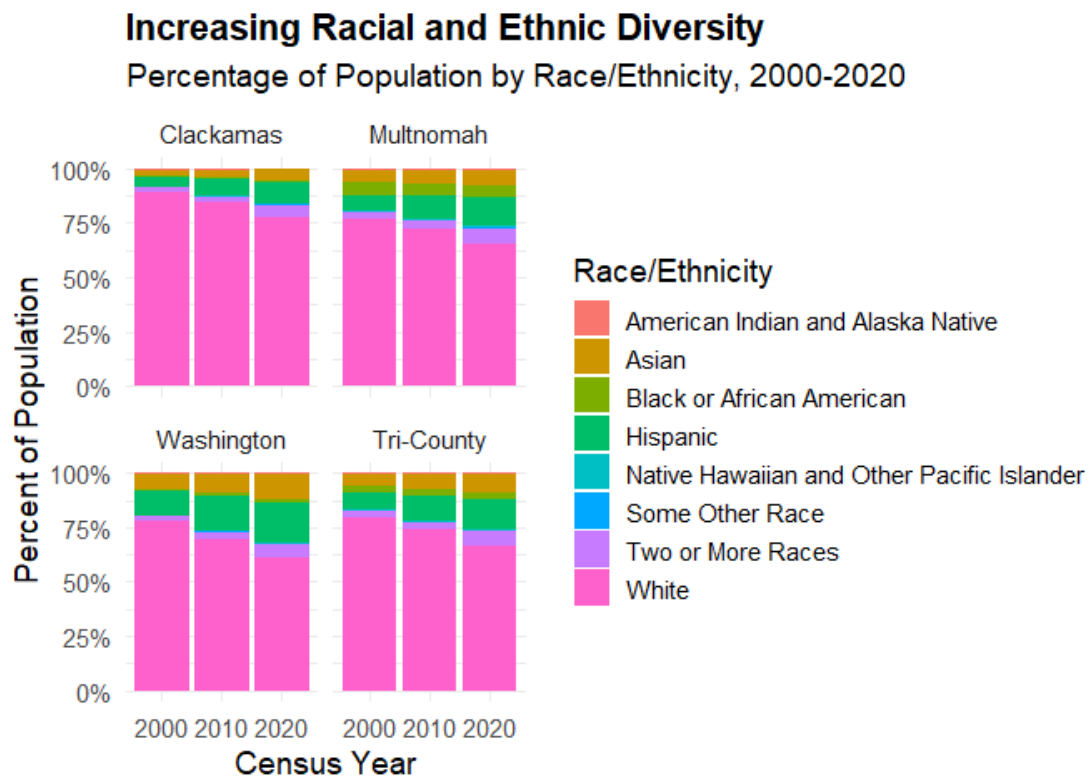

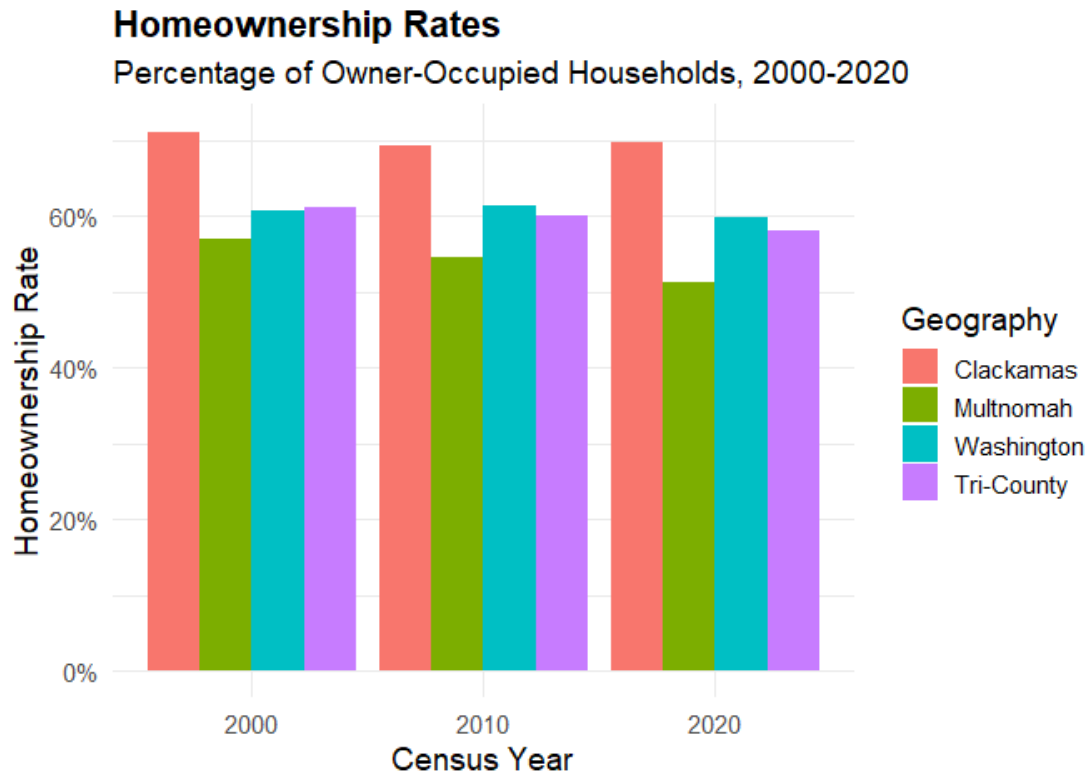

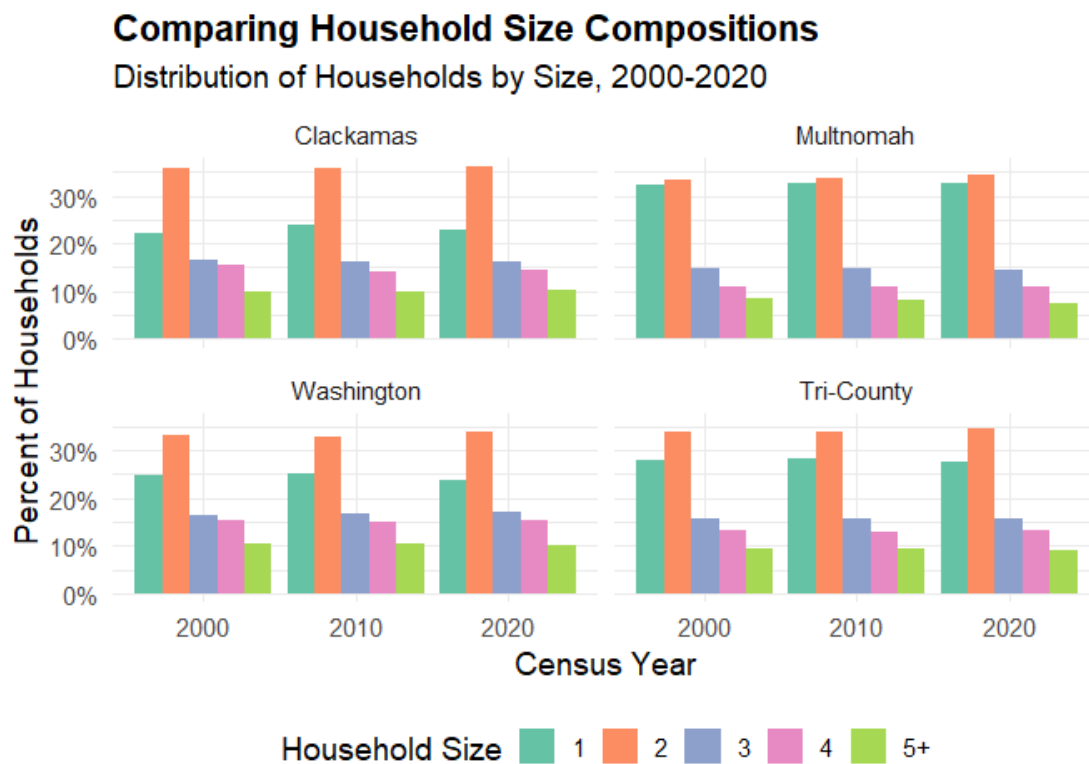
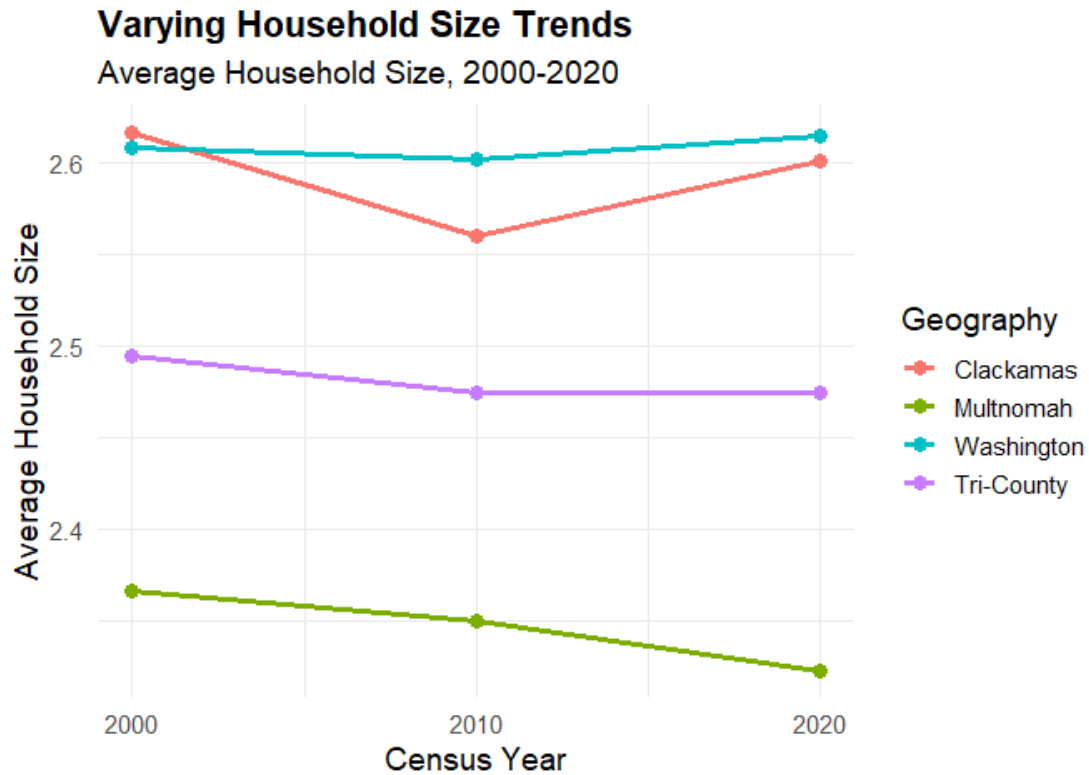

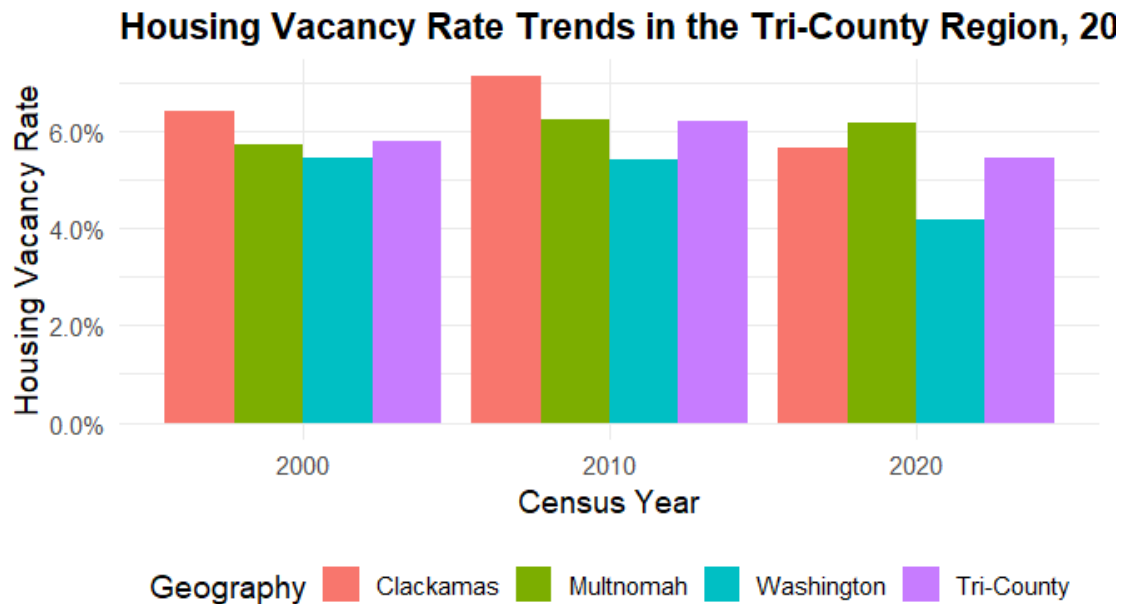

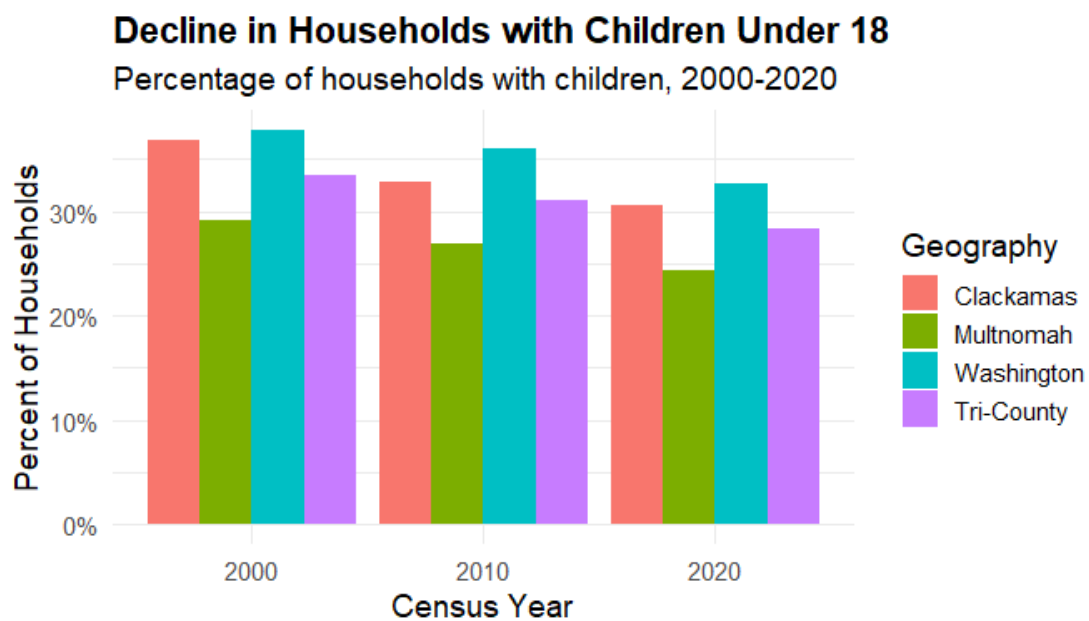

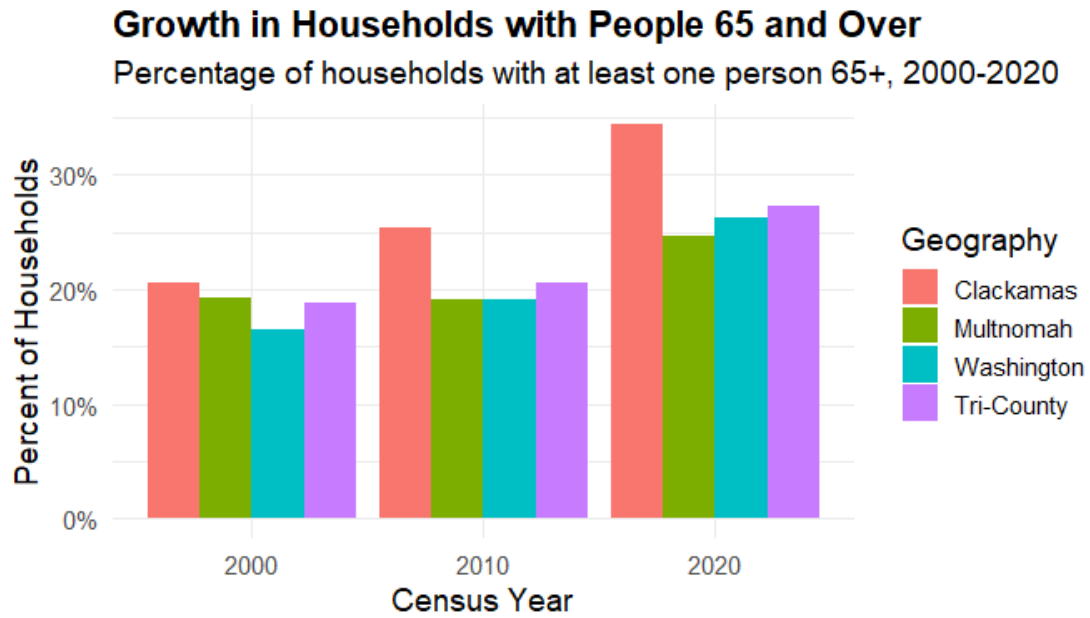

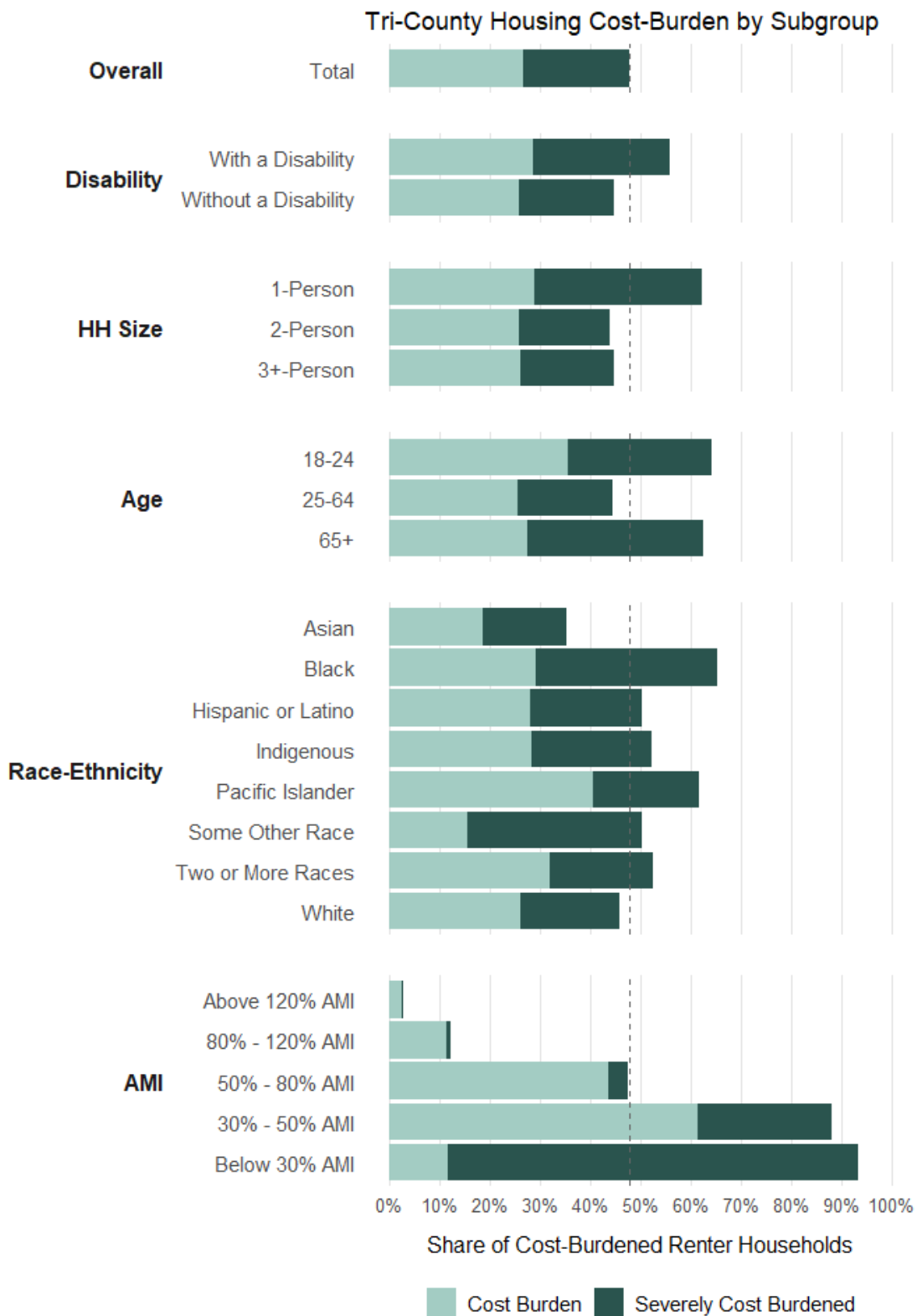
