ISSUE STATEMENT

The Regional Waste Advisory Committee advises Metro Council on the management of the garbage and recycling system. The committee has five seats for local jurisdictions. One seat held by the City of Portland is being transitioned to an elected official of the city. Resolution No. 25-5485 appoints one member to complete the remaining time of a two-year term for the City of Portland.

ACTION REQUESTED

Approval of Resolution No. 25-5485, confirming the appointment of Angelita Morillo to the Regional Waste Advisory Committee to complete the remaining time of a two-year term that will conclude on December 31, 2026.

STRATEGIC CONTEXT

In June 2024, Metro Council expanded the scope and membership of the committee. These changes were made to increase collaboration and transparency and build trust in investments in regional priorities and budget and fee development. The policy committee is comprised of 17 members representing cities, counties, the public, and industry. Metro Code 2.19.130(d) gives the Metro Council President sole authority to appoint all members of the Regional Waste Advisory Committee. The appointments are confirmed by Metro Council.

PROPOSED MEMBER

City of Portland Councilor, Angelita Morillo

Angelita Morillo is one of three councilors representing District 3 in the City of Portland.
