Overview of Results

Total of \$51,500 across 47 award recipients.

- 19 directly serves the BIPOC community
- 24 Food Stability for the most vulnerable
- 13 Homeless services
- 8 Food stability and Housing support
- 4 Housing stability and support
- 4 Educational support for young students

Six additional requests were awarded thanks to contributions from Parks and Nature, WPES and DEI.

What we've heard

Most respondents have shared that they intend to continue service programs that have increased in need as a result of the pandemic.

- Food and housing stability continues to be a significant community need.
- Some community needs have shifted
 - Young students return to in-person learning
 - Service providers are offering more in-person support
 - Behavioral and mental health support is an on-going need exacerbated by the stress and anxiety of the pandemic
 - Supporting community vaccination awareness and localized vaccination clinics
