- Verbal comments and questions: ~200

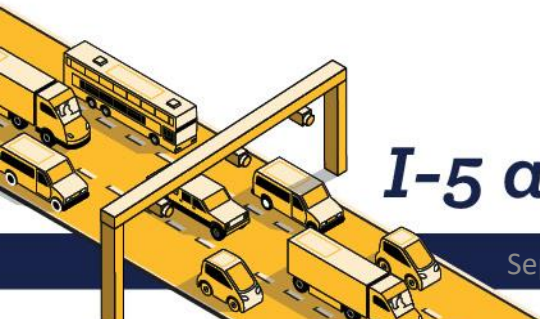


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Next Steps with I-205 Comment

September - October	Review and analyze comments
November	Draft summary report on comments received
November - December	Consider potential changes to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Purpose and Need, Goals and Objectives• Recommended alternatives for NEPA analysis
December-January	Publish report with recommendations
