WHEREAS, Metro owns and operates the Portland Expo Center, a multi-purpose event facility, located at 2060 N. Marine Drive, Portland, Oregon (the “Expo Property”);

WHEREAS, TriMet operates a Max Light Rail stop at the easternmost border of the Expo Property, which stop is commonly referred to as the Expo Center Park and Ride, or the TriMet Yellow Line;

WHEREAS, in 2003, Metro, MERC and TriMet entered into an agreement that allowed TriMet to operate a park and ride facility at the Expo Property; and

WHEREAS, Metro desires to modify and renew the existing agreement with TriMet to provide for continued Park and Ride use at the Expo Property; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the Metro Council hereby authorizes the Executive Director of the Portland Expo Center to enter into a Park and Ride agreement with TriMet substantially similar to the attached Exhibit A, or as otherwise approved by the Office of Metro Attorney.
