## Hillsboro's strategy

- \$40.7M to fund 284 affordable homes
- \$856K in program administration funding
- Coordinated county-wide engagement reached over 500 community members
- 2-5 projects anticipated; priority for development on city owned land
- 20% COBID/MWESB participation goal
- City Council approved the IGA on Jan. 6
