WHEREAS, at the general election held on November 6, 2018, the Metro Area voters approved a ballot measure authorizing the issuance of general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$652,800,000.00 for the purpose of funding affordable housing (the "Affordable Housing Bond Measure"); and

WHEREAS, Metro Code Chapter 2.19 establishes the Metro Affordable Housing Bond Community Oversight Committee, whose members are appointed by the Metro Council President subject to confirmation by the Metro Council; and

WHEREAS, the Metro Council President has appointed two new members of the Metro Affordable Housing Bond Committee Oversight Committee to replace members who were unable to continue serving; and

WHEREAS, the Metro Council President has reappointed five members of the Metro Affordable Housing Bond Committee Oversight Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Metro Council desires to confirm those appointments and reappointments; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the Metro Council confirms the appointments and reappointments to the Metro Housing Bond Community Oversight Committee as set forth on Exhibit A, attached hereto.
