Council work session

2:00 Call to Order and Roll Call

Council President Lynn Peterson called the Metro Council work session call to order at: 2:01 p.m.

Present: 7 - Council President Lynn Peterson, Councilor Sam Chase, Councilor Christine Lewis, Councilor Shirley Craddick, Councilor Craig Dirksen, Councilor Juan Carlos Gonzalez, and Councilor Bob Stacey

Work Session Topics:

2:05 Regional Investment Strategy: Transportation Investment Measure Refinement

Council President Peterson introduced Mr. Andy Shaw, Director of Government Affairs, and Ms. Margi Bradway, Deputy Director of Planning to present on the transportation investment measure refinement. Mr. Shaw reviewed the agenda for the work session which included a revenue update, a review of final recommended corridor investments, a specific focus on Highway 43 planning and Highway 26 study, and then Council direction. He discussed the revenue update that included recent findings and recommended action.

Ms. Bradway reviewed the final list of recommended corridor investments which included the Southwest Corridor, TV Highway, 82nd Ave, Central City, Albina Vision, SW 185th, Highway 217, Pacific Highway 99W, Highway 212/Sunrise, Clackamas-to-Columbia/181st, 162nd, McLoughlin Blvd, Burnside, Powell Blvd, Highway 43 and Highway 26. She discussed design and design features of each corridor. Mr. Shaw then mentioned the next steps which included final project and program recommendations, partner's adoption of letters of commitment, and decisions needed.

Council Discussion

Councilor Dirksen requested clarification on the funding mechanisms for the measure.

Councilor Stacey inquired how partnerships would work to realign and reprioritize schedules to match the reduced revenue streams and still accomplish set objectives.

Councilor Craddick requested clarification on the revenue schedule.

Councilor Gonzalez requested a prioritization list since the revenue has changed.

Councilor Chase inquired on the limitations of the state funding.

Councilor Dirksen voiced his concern on the possibility of underfunding the measure.

Councilor Craddick echoed Councilor Dirksen's concerns.

Councilor Lewis voiced her appreciation for inclusion of safe sidewalks in 99W and McLoughlin Blvd.

Councilor Gonzalez commented on the need to list prioritization before the Council would vote for referral. He recommended the removal of the vehicle registration fee from the funding mechanisms.

Councilor Chase voiced his agreement with the drawn out timeline.

Councilor Stacey commented on the revenue stream.

Deputy Chief Operating Officer Andrew Scott discussed the reopening of the Oregon Zoo and potential funding allocation to P'5.

Councilor Gonzalez mentioned the four listening sessions for the transportation measure in each County.
